

Foreign Coaching Licences

1. Licencing of the German Tennis Association (DTB) is closely tied to the guidelines of the German Olympic Federation (DOSB). The purpose of the guidelines is to spread comparable training curricula in order to promote the work of developing young sport talents. Licences of foreign organizations are not accepted without extra examination according to the rules of the DOSB.
2. The DTB does not accept foreign licences leading to A-level coaching courses or examinations. Appropriate applicants are proposed to the DTB during an annual check lead by the Federal State Tennis Associations.
3. Responsible for assessing applicants willing to obtain a C-, or B-Coaching Licence is the Tennis Association Berlin- Brandenburg.
4. No foreign licence is accepted without participating and passing a C-or B-Coaching examination.
5. Qualified applicants are judged by a committee prior to which the applicant has to hand in certified copies of his/her licence.
6. Dependent on the applicant`s qualifications parts of the training courses or even all courses can be remitted.
7. The contents of the examination can be adapted:
 - an assessed teaching practice is mandatory
 - the theoretical part of the test can be oral or in written form
8. Expenses for training courses or examination fees have to be covered by the applicant.
